

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 3

CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF DERBY, KANSAS FROM SECTION 12-112 of the 1959 SUPPLEMENT TO THE GENERAL STATUTES OF KANSAS, 1949, AND PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE AND ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS FOR THE SAME SUBJECT, AND PROVIDING FOR THE SALARIES OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF DERBY, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The City of Derby, Kansas, a mayor council city of the second class by the power invested in it, by Article 12, Section 5, of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, hereby elects and exempts itself, from and makes inapplicable to it Section 12-112 of the 1959 Supplement of the General Statutes of Kansas, 1949. Said section not being applicable uniformly to all cities and applying to the City of Derby, and to provide substitute provisions as hereinafter provided.

SECTION 2. The Governing Body of the City of Derby, Kansas, shall by Ordinance fix the salary of any member of the governing body, including the Mayor, provided the salary shall not exceed the sum of \$30.00 per month for the Mayor and the sum of \$3.00 per regular council meeting per councilman. The salary so fixed shall become effective on the effective date of said ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

SECTION 4. This is a charter ordinance and shall take effect sixty one (61) days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum held on the ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5, Subdivision (c) (3) of the Constitution of Kansas, in which case the ordinance shall become effective if approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

Passed by the Governing Body, not less than two thirds of the members-elect voting in favor thereof, the 7 day of May, 1963.
