

# Derby Senior Center Reopening Guidelines

Effective June 17, 2020



## Protocol

All members, visitors, and volunteers will be required to sanitize their hands prior to coming into the Senior Center

- Sanitation stations with hand sanitizer) will be at each check-in kiosk along with signage at the front and back doors directing members to sanitize, check-in, and report to the lobby front desk.
- Once signed-in, members/volunteers/visitors must go to the front desk to receive a mask if needed, have their temperatures read and a short questionnaire reviewed. If a member/volunteer/visitor has a reading over 100 degrees they will be prohibited from entering the center. Masks must be worn while in the building, except during exercise.
- Gloves are available at the front desk upon request.
- Senior Center staff will conduct checks periodically to ensure social distancing is being followed and PPE is being used.

## Austin Room

30 "X" marks have been placed on the floor for exercise classes; 15 table pods can be set up for a total up to 60 people for programming.

Classes include exercise classes, movies, birthday bingo, and bunco babes.

**Multi-Purpose Room:** Accommodates 40 people

Classes include Joy of Singing, Quilters and Hooks and Needles groups.

**Game Room:** Accommodates up to 20 people with five table pods.

**Conference Room:** Grief counseling and meetings with four or less people.

**Exercise Room:** Adjusted to reflect social distancing by using every other machine.

**Computer Lab:** Half the number of computers will be available.

**Meals on Wheels:** Delivery services are still available. You may opt to practice social distancing during congregate meals or take your lunch to go.

**Cancellations:** Community dances, progressive bingo, massage therapy, billiards and group trips have been cancelled until further notice.
